## The electronic registration function has appeared on the website of the international Eurasian Week Forum

**Russia, Moscow, June 14, 2017** – There has been launched the website of the international Eurasian Week Forum [www.eurasianweek.org](http://www.eurasianweek.org), the largest annual business event, the goal of which is to develop the economy, investment and export potential of the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) Member States. The Forum is held by the EAEU and the Eurasian Economic Commission Member States.

On the website one can get all the necessary information on the timing and the program of the Forum, apply for participation and pass an electronic registration.

The Eurasian Week will be an effective platform for the development of B2B contacts, discussion of tools and conditions for business development created in the EAEU, as well as to jointly elaborate strategic decisions for the EAEU economic development in the context of global challenges. At the Forum there will be discussed issues of creating opportunities for the export of goods and services produced in the EAEU and investments in the Union Member states.

The forum is listed among 18 most significant events of the world's fair EXPO-2017 business part. The global topics of the Eurasian Week will be: "Competitiveness in the modern economic conditions: growth potentials" (on the first day), "Unified markets for goods, services, labour and finance on the EAEU territory: present and future" (on the second day), "Economics of the Future: strategical directions of business development" (on the third day). The general focus of the business program and the exhibition is the development of the EAEU Member States export potential.

### For reference:

*The initiative to hold the annual Eurasian Week forum was approved by the prime ministers of five EAEU countries in May 2015.*

*The first Eurasian Week was held in October 2016 on the sidelines of the International Moscow Forum and Open Innovations development show.*

*The business program included 16 thematic workshops with the participation of business and expert circles of Union member-states and third countries (Vietnam, Singapore, Egypt, South Korea, and EU countries). More than 400 speakers came out at the Forum. The exhibition part of*

*the forum involved 43 exhibitors from Union countries and launched B2B interaction. The forum was attended by more than 2,000 persons.*
